








- EB and WB Gardiner ramps are permanently closed – September 2021
- Lake Shore road construction for temp diversion – September to October 2021
- Don Roadway is closed from Lake Shore to Villiers – September 2021 to December 2024


CURRENT SCHEDULE:

- Existing 3 westbound (WB) lanes on Lake Shore are converted to 2 EB +1 WB lanes in October 2021
- New Cherry Street, from Commissioners to Polson Street is opened – November 2021
- Old Cherry Street between Polson and Commissioners is permanently closed – November 2021
- Commissioners between Old Cherry and New Cherry is open – November 2021




Traffic Configuration Don Roadway – Lake Shore Blvd. E




- Commissioners Street opened August 2022




