# 1. Challenge Timeline

<u>Challenge Deadline</u>: Please note that the submission deadline has been extended from May 7 at 11:59pm to **May 30 2021 at 11:59 pm (local time)** 

## 2. <u>Design Development Clarification</u>

Design Development: Waterfront Toronto is flexible on the nature of progress that the winning team is able to complete in the six months following the award of the honorarium. Please note that only the selected team that receives the \$30,000 honorarium will be expected to provide an update to Waterfront Toronto as to how they have advanced their design. At a minimum, the selected team will be expected to provide the following materials:

- 1. Report (approx. 15-20 pgs) including the following items:
  - i. Summary of progress made over the past six months on the proposed design
  - ii. Depending on the nature of the proposal, the team will be expected to provide the following visual material:
    - 1. Physical Platform: 3D Model and 2D images, including section and plan views
    - 2. Digital Platform: Video or image walkthrough navigating the platform
  - iii. Updated costing for potential implementation into the PLFP project
  - iv. Identification of potential barriers to implementation
- 2. 45-60 minute presentation to WT outlining the key elements of the report.

#### 3. Evaluation, Selection and Award Process

**Evaluation Clarification**: The process for evaluating received proposals is divided into two phases, General Scoring and Honorarium Scoring. All proposals received by the deadline will be evaluated by the selection jury according to the General Scoring Criteria. From these scores, three proposals will be selected that will then



be evaluated according to the Honorarium scoring criteria by the jury panel. The proposal with the highest score will be awarded the honorarium in addition to a \$10,000 prize while the two finalist proposals will be each awarded a 10,000 prize.
