

### **Traffic Notice**

## Nightly Closures of Villiers Street between Don Roadway and Saulter Street: October 30-November 30, 2023

To facilitate infrastructure work undertaken by Enbridge Gas, Villiers Street will be closed between Don Roadway and Saulter Street from 8p.m. to 6a.m. nightly, starting October 30<sup>th</sup>. The nightly closures will be in place until November 30<sup>th</sup>. The recommended detour is Lake Shore Boulevard. The TTC #72 Bus will be running on diversion. Cyclists and pedestrian access will remain open.

#### What to expect - Vehicle Traffic:

- Villiers Street will remain open between Cherry Street and Don Roadway, and access to businesses on Villiers Street will be maintained.
- The closure will be marked by traffic cones.
- To travel east from the Port Lands: take Cherry Street north to Lake Shore Boulevard East, turn right on to Lake Shore Boulevard East.
- To travel into the Port Lands from the east: Left turns are not permitted from westbound Lake Shore Boulevard on to Cherry Street southbound. Take Leslie Street south to Unwin Avenue, and go west on Unwin Avenue to Cherry Street. Alternatively, travel farther west than Cherry Street, and turn around to approach the Port Lands from eastbound Lake Shore Boulevard.

#### What to expect - Cyclists and Pedestrians:

- The sidewalk on the north side of Villiers Street between Cherry Street and Saulter Street will be closed. Signage will redirect pedestrians to the south side.
- The cycle track on the north side of Villiers Street between Cherry Street and Saulter Street will be closed. The south cycle track will be converted to a bi-directional cycle track, between Cherry Street and Saulter Street.

# No access southbound to Logan Avenue or Bouchette Street from Lake Shore Boulevard East: October 25 – November 10

To facilitate roadwork on Lake Shore Boulevard East, the south side of the intersection of Lake Shore Boulevard with Logan Avenue and Bouchette Streets will be closed between October 25th-November 10th. Access to these streets is available from Commissioners Street.

#### What to expect:

- From Lake Shore Boulevard, there will be no access southbound on to Logan Avenue or Bouchette Street.
- The closure will be marked by traffic barrels.
- To access Logan Avenue or Bouchette Street south of Lake Shore Boulevard, go south on Carlaw Avenue from Lake Shore Boulevard. Turn right on to Commissioners Street. Turn right on to Logan Avenue or Bouchette Street.
