

Traffic Notice

Ramp to Don Valley Parkway to/from Lake Shore Boulevard East Closed: Weekend of May 10-12

To facilitate utilities work at Don Roadway and Lake Shore Boulevard East, the ramp to and from the Don Valley Parkway (DVP) and Lake Shore Boulevard will be closed from 10:30 p.m., Friday May 10, reopening at 5:30 a.m. Sunday, May 12.



Above: A map showing the location of the DVP Ramp closure.


What to expect from 10:30 p.m. Friday, May 10 to 5:30 a.m. Sunday, May 12:

- There will be no access to the DVP from Lake Shore Boulevard East
- The exit from the DVP to Lake Shore Boulevard East will be closed
- The closure will be marked with traffic cones and a signage truck
- Access to the northbound DVP from westbound Lake Shore Boulevard is via the Queen St. on ramp. From Lake Shore Boulevard westbound, go north on Carlaw Avenue, west on Queen Street, north on Davies Ave, and then take the ramp on the left
- Access to the northbound DVP from eastbound Lake Shore Boulevard is via the Eastern Avenue on ramp. From eastbound Lake Shore Boulevard, go north on Cherry Street, east on Eastern Avenue, and then take the ramp on the right.

No Access Between Morse Street and Lake Shore Boulevard East: May 10-12

Between May 10 at 10p.m. and May 12 at 11p.m., the intersection of Lake Shore Boulevard and Morse Street will be closed. During this work, access to Morse Street will be via the laneways that connect to Carlaw Avenue and Logan Avenue.

This closure is needed because workers will be installing underground utilities.

What to expect from 10 p.m. Friday, May 10 to 11 p.m. Sunday, May 12:

- There will be no access to Lake Shore Boulevard from Morse Street
- There will be no access to Morse Street from Lake Shore Boulevard
- Access to Morse Street will be via the laneways that connect to Carlaw Avenue and Logan Avenue
