Location: At the Environmental Shelter in Tommy Thompson Park. The park is located at the foot of Leslie Street, south of Lake Shore Boulevard East.

Transit: From Bloor/Danforth Subway, take the 83 Jones bus from Donlands Station to Commissioners Street, and continue a short distance south. From Downtown, take the 501 Queen Streetcar to Leslie Street and then catch the 83 Jones bus south.

Parking: Free parking is available on Unwin Avenue or Leslie Street, and in the Tommy Thompson Park Parking Lot.
